

ACCESSORIES: PURSE MADE FROM A TETRA BRICK



MATERIALS REQUIRED

A long tetra brick container and scissors.

DEGREE OF DIFFICULTY

Medium.

APPROXIMATED TIME REQUIRED

3 hours.

LEARNING GOALS

Learn how to make useful and original items using tetra brick containers.

ABILITIES DEVELOPED

Attention, determination, fine handling, accuracy, hand-eye dexterity, memory, creativity.



STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS

1. Cut the tetra brick's base.

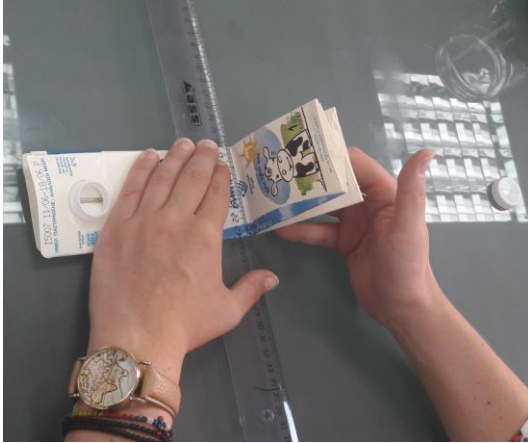


2. Open the tetra brick so that it is completely flat.





3. Cut one centimetre from the upper part.
4. Fold the sides inwards.
5. Imagine a line that divides the tetra brick in three equal parts and fold it following them.

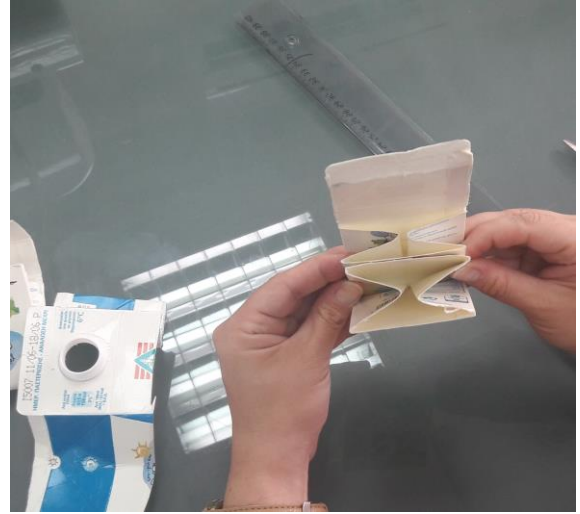


6. Cut the sides of the lower part (the further one from the stopper).





7. Fold the parts so it looks like this:



8. Staple both sides to hold the folded, as seen in the photo.



9. Glue the part with the stopper.





10. Cut one hole on the lid through which you can get the stopper.



11. The stopper will be the purse's fastener.



TIPS

This material is quite hard and it is difficult to work with it, so be patient and bend it carefully.

If the tetra brick you choose is colourfull or has a colourfull stopper, your purse will be more original.

You can round off the borders, it will look much nicer.
