

HOME: JARS MADE FROM FOOD CANS



MATERIALS REQUIRED

Food cans, colourful fabrics, scissors, and glue.

DEGREE OF DIFFICULTY

Medium.

APPROXIMATE TIME REQUIRED

2 hours.

LEARNING GOALS

Learn how to line cans with fabric and create storage cans (where to put pens, sewing materials, tools...).

ABILITIES DEVELOPED

Attention, fine handling, hand-eye dexterity, creativity.

STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS

1. Firstly, clean the can thoroughly. Also, make sure it does not have any sharp edges and if you find any take it off with a metal file.
2. Measure the can; its height and outline.
3. Pick up a piece of fabric and draw on it a rectangle with the measurements that you have just obtained.
4. Cut the fabric.



5. Glue the fabric to the can. We recommend you using spray adhesive, because it will spread uniformly all over the surface and you will not find any lump.



TIPS

You can use craft scissors (the ones that cuts with different shapes) and your design will be even more attractive.



You can use different materials to achieve different results, like textile for decoration, rubber, plastic or felt, as you can see in the photos below.
